This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Additional mileage (price per mile above 15 miles collection)	£2

Sustainability

We know that many of our families want to do their bit for the environment, and it's no different when it comes to organising a funeral. There are lots of small things we can do to make a difference, as well finding a natural burial ground.



Coffins

You can choose a coffin with a lower environmental impact, like our Natural Wood coffin, made with wooden handles and less plastic, making it suitable for use in both cremation and burial grounds. We also offer other natural alternatives such as wicker, cardboard, and rattan.



Flowers

Flowers make a lovely tribute to the person you're saying goodbye to, but often use lots of plastic which gets left at the crematorium or burial ground. Ask us about creating something that's kinder to the environment, or think about taking the flowers with you after the service to enjoy them at home.

Transport

We can help with alternative transport, like our bicycle hearse. If that's not for you, think about the service location to keep travel times shorter for the guests, or car-sharing to lower emissions on the way to and from the funeral.



Memorialisation

There are lots of ways to remember someone, including choices which will benefit the environment, like planting a tree or a rose bush in their name. If you choose cremation and want to bury the ashes, we can help with a biodegradable urn made using natural materials which slowly biodegrade into the soil. You can name a tree after the person who's died, and our partner Eforests will plant a tree for them, which you can visit.
